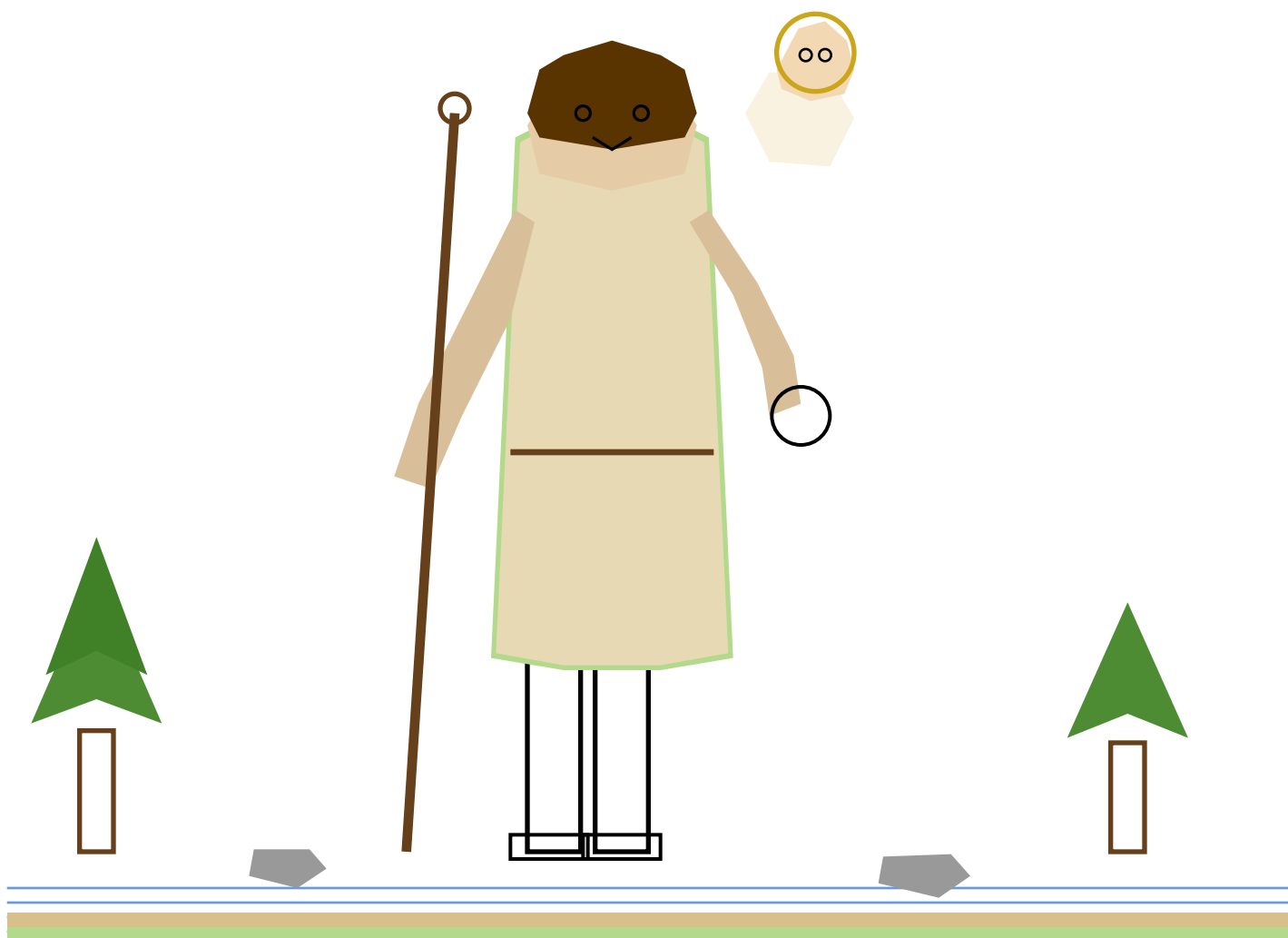
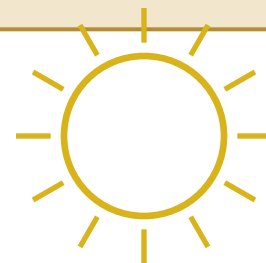


Saint Christopher – Patron of Travelers

Did you know? About St Christopher:

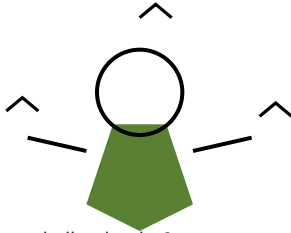

St Francis of Assisi

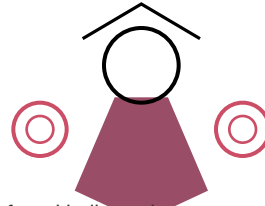
Feast Day: October 4

Feast Day: December 6



St Nicholas gave secret gifts of gold to people in need, especially children. His kindness became the legend of Santa Claus! He was a real bishop who prayed and gave generously.
